Some Chevy Trivia!

The El Camino first came out on the body of an Impala, but only from 1959-1960. Then it came back in 1964 on the base of a Chevelle.

Chevrolet introduced the two-speed automatic Powerglide transmission in 1950. It was the first automatic transmission offered in a low-priced automobile.

The Chevrolet bowtie emblem first appeared on the 1914 H-Series and L-Series models.

Starting in mid-1964, the Chevelle could be ordered with a 327-cubic-inch V8, in either 250 or 300 hp. Both used a four-barrel carburetor and 10.5:1 compression.

From 1947 to 1955, Advance-Design Chevrolet trucks were number one in sales in the US, and were their first major redesign after WWII. They were larger, stronger, and a sleeker design compared to the earlier AK Series.

The correct firing order for a 1967 Camaro RS with a small block 327 V8 is 1-8-4-3-6-5-7-2.
